SHORT WINS OPENING ROUND OF KING OF INDIANA SPRINT SERIES AT BLOOMINGTON  
DeMOSS, HINES ALSO WIN FEATURE RACES

BLOOMINGTON, Ind. – 54 sprint cars came to Bloomington Speedway to fight for the feature win in the first round of the King of Indiana Sprint Series on Friday, May 6. Heavy hitters like 2010 KISS champion Jon Stanbrough, of Avon Ind., and Dave Darland, of Lincoln Ind., were included in the mass of competitors.

The event showcased the Grimes Pools & Spas Sprint Cars, the O’Neal Wood Products UMP Modifieds, and the Tire and Wheel Center UMP Super Stocks. Brady Short, John DeMoss, and Jeremy Hines were each able to earn feature race victories for their classes.

Short, of Bedford Ind., started on the inside of the second row and charged around the outside of the red clay oval to win the \$2,500 prize in the KISS feature race. Short was one of the few drivers able to make the outside groove work as most drivers battled around the inside of the track. Just before the midpoint in the race, Short grabbed the lead from pole sitter Kent Christian, of Clayton Ind., and cruised to his second straight Grimes Pools & Spas Sprint Car victory at Bloomington Speedway.

DeMoss, of Bloomington Ind., brought his car across the line first in the O’Neal Wood Products UMP Modifieds feature race after fighting his way to the front during the early laps of the event. DeMoss, who deftly maneuvered around the leaders, got out in front of Justin Bex, of Mitchell Ind., and never looked back. He notched his second straight Bloomington Speedway feature victory by standing on the accelerator and leaving his competitors in the dust.

Jeremy Hines, of Seymour Ind., took home the trophy in a caution filled Tire and Wheel Center UMP Super Stock feature. The feature started with 19 super stock cars but on-track incidents brought the final car count down to 15. Hines dueled with Chris Hillman, of Camby Ind., after every restart but was able to build a strong lead through each green flag period of racing. After the final restart, Brad Cummings, of Bedford Ind., was able to sneak by Hillman and into the second position leaving Hillman to edge out Troy Clark, of North Vernon Ind., to get the third spot on the podium.

The next night of racing at Bloomington Speedway is Friday, May 13. The American Modified Series will headline the event and will be joined by the always exciting Tire and Wheel Center UMP Super Stocks, the Chad’s Towing and Recovery Hornets, and Bomber cars. Gates open at 5:30pm, and general admission tickets are \$12 with children 12 and under FREE with a paying adult.
