DAVE DARLAND VICTORIOUS IN FAST AND FURIOUS FEATURE RACE
DeMOSS ALSO WINS FEATURE BEFORE RAIN POSTPONES FURTHER TRACK ACTION

BLOOMINGTON, Ind. – Racers at Bloomington Speedway found themselves racing just as furiously against their competition as they did against the weather during B97 Night on Friday, June 17. The rain-shortened event included the Grimes Pools & Spas Sprint Cars, the Tire & Wheel Center UMP Super Stocks, the O’Neal Wood Products UMP Modifieds and the Chad’s Towing and Recovery Hornets. Dave Darland won the sprint car feature and Clint DeMoss took the checkered in the modified feature race before rain came to the track.

20 year-old Chris Babcock, of Bloomfield Ind., grabbed the lead of the Grimes Pools & Spas Sprint Car feature race as the green flag fell and quickly drove away from the field. A very fast track allowed Babcock to put the hammer down and lap cars before hitting the halfway point. A yellow that those lapped cars caused right at the midpoint of the race would be Babcock’s undoing. On the restart, Babcock bobbed between Turn One and Turn Two and surrendered the lead to a lurking Nick Bilbee, of Indianapolis. Bilbee then dominated the waning laps of the race only to suffer the same fate as Babcock when, with one lap to go, slower cars forced him into the infield grass at the bottom of Turn Four. Dave Darland, of Lincoln Ind., who had been methodically picking his way through the field, found himself the benefactor of Bilbee’s misfortune and grabbed the checkered flag.

Clint DeMoss, of Bloomington Ind., started from the outside of the second row and duelled with Bradley Sterrett, of Bloomington Ind., in the O’Neal Wood Products UMP Modified feature race. Sterrett, who had started on the outside of the first row, stood on his accelerator and set a blistering pace before lapped traffic allowed DeMoss to squeeze into the lead. Lapped traffic again held Sterrett up and opened the door for a hard-charging Richie Lex, of Morgantown Ind., to battle for the lead with DeMoss. Slicing their way through slower cars, DeMoss and Lex took their fight all the way to the line with DeMoss taking the win by a single car length.

Just after the twin checkers fell on the Grimes Pools & Spas Sprint Car feature race, strong rain swamped the track and made it unsafe for further racing. Both the Tire and Wheel Center UMP Super Stocks and the Chad’s Towing and Recovery Hornet feature races were postponed. The postponed features will be made up on another date that was yet to be determined at time of print.

The next scheduled night of racing at Bloomington Speedway is 23rd Annual Sheldon Kinser Memorial and JD Byrider Night on Friday, June 24. It features the Grimes Pools & Spas Sprint Cars, the Tire & Wheel Center UMP Super Stocks and the O’Neal Wood Products UMP Modifieds. Gates open at 5:30 p.m., hot laps start at 6:30 p.m. with racing getting under way at 7:30 p.m. General admission tickets are \$20 with children 12 and under FREE with a paying adult.
