JON STANBROUGH TAKES \$5,000 PRIZE IN SEASON FINALE FALL CLASH FEATURE RACE
HINES, MILES ALSO FIND VICTORY LANE

BLOOMINGTON, Ind. – The stars and cars of the Midwest Sprint Car Series stormed into Bloomington Speedway and delivered an exciting evening of open wheel action for the season finale during Indiana Stoneworks Night on Friday, September 16. The MSCS brought 40 cars and fought furiously all the way around the red clay oval for a big \$5,000 prize.

The full event card featured the MSCS Sprint Cars, the Tire and Wheel Center UMP Indiana Super Stocks and the Chad's Towing and Recovery Hornets. Jon Stanbrough took the top spot in the Midwest Sprint Car Series Sprint Car feature race while Jeremy Hines and Cole Miles were victorious in their respective classes.

Stanbrough, of Avon Ind., started on the outside of the front row for the MSCS feature race and quickly surged into the lead on the first lap. The race featured fierce side by side and wheel to wheel battles throughout the field as the event finished without a single caution period. Lap after lap, Stanbrough battled on the low side with Levi Jones, of Olney Ill., and the two were forced to duel their way through lapped traffic. In the end, Jones made a final push to get around Stanbrough but came up short by less than a foot at the line as Stanbrough went wire to wire for the win. Brady Short, of Bedford Ind., won the 2011 Bloomington Speedway Sprint Car Track Championship.

Cullen Goodman, of Hymera Ind., started the Tire and Wheel Center UMP Indiana Super Stock from the pole position and led for much of the event. While battles raged door handle to door handle, Goodman fended off challenges from Richie Lex, of Morgantown Ind., and Travis Howe, of Mitchell Ind. As the laps ticked away, Jeremy Hines, of Seymour Ind., thundered his way into the lead pack after starting near the end of the field. Hines put the hammer down and jumped into the lead with just five laps remaining. On the final restart, Hines was able to hold off Lex for the win and earned the 2011 Bloomington Speedway Super Stock Track Championship.

Cole Miles, of Bloomington Ind., started back in the third row of the Chad's Towing and Recovery Hornets feature race and methodically worked his way through the field to challenge pole sitter Jay Fleetwood, of Bedford Ind. Fleetwood led the majority of a Hornet feature that featured side by side and wheel to wheel racing around the track. The final five laps featured an intense nose to tail and door handle to door handle duel between Miles and Fleetwood. With one lap remaining in the event, Miles got underneath Fleetwood and motored to victory lane.

The next event on Bloomington Speedway's schedule is the awards banquet on Saturday, December 3. The event will be held at Terry's Banquets and Catering Center in Bloomington.
