**SCHATZ STORMS TO VICTORY IN WORLD OF OUTLAWS' RETURN TO  
BLOOMINGTON SPEEDWAY**  
JOHN DeMOSS TAKES MODIFIED FEATURE RACE

BLOOMINGTON, Ind. – The Greatest Show on Dirt brought a huge crowd to Bloomington Speedway as fans turned out in droves to see the World of Outlaws Sprint Car Series on Friday, August 5. The visit was the first at the red clay oval for the World of Outlaws since 1999.

Also returning to the quarter mile oval was Bloomington native and 20 time World of Outlaws Sprint Car champion Steve Kinser. The World of Outlaws Sprint Cars were joined on the event card by the O'Neal Wood Product UMP Modifieds.

Four time World of Outlaws Sprint Car Series champion Donny Schatz, of Fargo N.D., started on the front row of the sprint car feature and set an absolutely blistering pace for the field. For much of the event Schatz battled side by side and wheel to wheel with Jason Sides, of Bartlett Tenn. Schatz and Sides navigated through lapped traffic before an early caution set up a side by side restart.

As the green flag fell on the restart, the ultra-fast Schatz surged into the lead. Sides gave chase but slipped over the cushion and was forced to retire from the race only a few laps later. Lurking just behind the leaders, Lucas Wolfe, of Mechanicsburg Pa., took up the challenge and began to reel in Schatz. Wolfe was closing the gap with one lap to go as a flipping Austen Wheatley, of Lake Stevens Wash., forced a green-white-checker finish. In the closing laps of the race, Schatz chose the inside line and cruised to victory while Wolfe was left to tangle with Paul McMahan, of Nashville Tenn., for the runner-up position. Bloomington native Steve Kinser would take home the sixth position.

Rob Fuqua, of Paris Ill., started in the pole position of the O'Neal Wood Products UMP Modified feature race and was immediately locked in an epic battle with John DeMoss, of Bloomington Ind., and Clint DeMoss, of Bloomington Ind. The three drivers took their fight through the halfway mark before a spin knocked Fuqua out of contention. Fuqua's exit set up a brotherly battle between the DeMosses and the two didn't disappoint. Heading into the final six laps of the event, John DeMoss was able to jump out in front and hold off younger brother Clint DeMoss to take home the checkered flag.

The next night of racing at Bloomington Speedway is the 11<sup>th</sup> Annual South Central Building & Construction Trade Council Night on Friday, August 12. The event features the Grimes Pools and Spas Sprint Cars, the O'Neal Wood Products UMP Modifieds, the Tire and Wheel Center UMP Super Stocks and the Chad's Towing and Recovery Hornets. Gates open at 5:30 p.m., hot laps start at 6:30 p.m. with racing getting under way at 7:30 p.m. General admission tickets are \$12 with children 12 and under FREE with a paying adult.
