HUNTER SCHUERENBERG WINS ROUND SIX OF USAC INDIANA SPRINT WEEK
HENNING STEALS MINI SPRINT FEATURE AT BLOOMINGTON SPEEDWAY

BLOOMINGTON, Ind. – 45 of the best United States Auto Club Sprint Cars thundered into Bloomington Speedway for the sixth round of the 24th Annual Indiana Sprint Week on Friday, July 15. Race fans packed the stands and filled the hillside to see the exciting night of high speed racing.

Joining the USAC Sprint Cars at the quarter mile oval were the Midwest Mini Sprint Association Mini Sprint Cars. The mini sprint cars competed at Bloomington Speedway as a part of their Mini Sprint Week.

Wes McIntyre, of McCordsville Ind., and Hunter Schuerenberg, of Sikeston Mo., started on the front row of the feature race in 6th round of the 2011 Indiana Sprint Week and dueled fiercely for the lead. McIntyre jumped on to the cushion and worked the high line while Schuerenberg hustled his way around the inside of the red clay oval. A late race caution set up a nine lap dash to the checkered flag.

After getting loose and losing ground to Schuerenberg, McIntyre got caught up in an accident in Turn Four with just two laps remaining. The shootout to the finish came down to Schuerenberg, Dave Darland, of Lincoln Ind., and Bloomington Speedway regular competitor, Danny Holtsclaw, of Bloomfield Ind. As the green flag fell, Schuerenberg shot out to a large lead and left Darland and Holtsclaw to fight for second. Schuerenberg cruised to victory lane while Darland edged out Holtsclaw for second place at the line.

Rob Winks, of Piqua Ohio, jumped out in front of the Midwest Mini Sprint Association feature race and set a blistering pace for the field. In pursuit, Rod Henning, of Middletown Ohio, and Don Harvey, of Milford N.Y., dropped the hammer and battled each other for second position. As the laps ticked away it looked to be Winks' race to lose while he extended his advantage over the field. Behind Winks, the field battled wheel to wheel and three wide for position.

After a late red flag period set up a five lap showdown between the leaders, Winks began to fade. Henning immediately ran around the outside and into the lead while Harvey was left to fight with Kevin Roberts Sr., of Greenfield Ohio, for second position. As Henning came away with the checkered flag, Roberts Sr. snuck around the outside of Harvey for the runner up spot.

The next scheduled night of racing at Bloomington Speedway is the Rose and Walker Night on Friday, July 22. The event features the Grimes Pools and Spas Sprint Cars, the O'Neal Wood Products UMP Modifieds, the Tire and Wheel Center UMP Super Stocks and the Chad's Towing and Recovery Hornets. Gates open at 5:30 p.m., hot laps start at 6:30 p.m. with racing getting under way at 7:30 p.m. General admission tickets are \$12 with children 12 and under FREE with a paying adult.
